### Small Arms Trainer System

Half of the group will be placed in the small arms trainer system where they will have a chance to handle and fire the C7 Rifle and 9mm pistol (no live ammo is used, compressed gas simulation). There will be realistic scenarios in the simulator for participants to engage targets at differing levels of difficulty.

### Leadership Training Course Observation

The second half of the group will go to building M5, next door to the main building, where they will have a chance to observe some of the leadership training courses 5CDTC is currently conducting.

#### 1000 **Field Deployment**

Participants will be bussed to the Ranges where they will "deploy" to the field for the remainder of the visit as an opportunity to experience in real time how the soldiers train.

#### 1045 **Tactical Armoured Patrol Vehicle Driver Course Visit**

The group will have the unique opportunity to ride along with the TAPV course as they conduct cross-country driving in an armoured vehicle.

Participants will break for lunch and have the opportunity to interact with the course participants, staff and the 5th Canadian Division Training Center Leadership.
